Wedding Photography Contract & T&C's

- Xposure Photography (photographer) is the exclusive photographer during the wedding event. Others wishing to take photos may do so, but out of the way of the photographer.
- Upon signing of this agreement, the photographer will reserve the date and time agreed upon and will not make another reservation for that specific date and time frame. For this reason, all deposits are non-refundable even if the date is changed or if the wedding becomes cancelled for any reason.
- If you would like to book me as your photographer, a non-refundable deposit of R2000 is required. If your wedding collection includes an album, a further payment of R2000 is required 2 weeks after your wedding. The full balance, of your wedding collection is then due upon delivery, approximately 4-6 weeks after your wedding.
- Travelling/petrol costs are included in all wedding collections for the first 100km's from Amanzimtoti, KZN. Thereafter a fee of R3 per km is charged.
- Accommodation is not included in any wedding collections. If the venue is further than 100km's away, accommodation may need to be provided for the photographer, if requested. (& assistant, if applicable)
- Please ensure that a seat and a meal at reception are provided for the photographer if your wedding collection includes reception coverage. (& assistant, if applicable)
- An assistant/2nd photographer may be required for full day (8hrs) coverage weddings. If applicable, the client is only responsible for their seat and meal at reception and accommodation, if required. This is at the sole discretion of Xposure Photography.
- Prices on albums and photo prints are subject to change due to varying print costs. Upon making a booking you will be notified of any such changes. No price changes are applicable after your deposit has been received.
- The custom design and layout of your photo-book/album is done at the sole discretion of Xposure Photography unless otherwise agreed upon by both parties.
- If more images are taken over and above your chosen or designed wedding collection, you will be offered an option to purchase them (edited) at a nominal fee.
- Xposure photography reserves the right to delete any images (blink shots, blurred images, etc.) and to modify images for artistic effect to ensure only high quality images.
- Xposure Photography does not permanently save or archive image files and is not responsible for the lifespan of any digital media provided. Upon receipt of a photo DVD, the client accepts all responsibility for saving, archiving and protecting the image files and digital media.
- Xposure photography reserves the right to use any images for advertising, publishing and promotional purposes, unless otherwise agreed upon by both parties.

- Xposure photography will strive to capture all agreed-upon wedding day moments. However, due to the spontaneous nature of weddings, Xposure Photography cannot be held responsible for any loss of data due to accident, death, theft, natural disaster, weather, possible equipment failure or any other circumstances beyond the control of Xposure Photography, on your wedding day, or thereafter. However, in the unlikely event that Xposure Photography is unable to comply with the terms of this contract, Xposure Photography's liability is limited solely to the refunding of the clients deposit.
